

## Assessment

At KS3, work is graded between A+ and E-. The following descriptions show broadly what you have to do to gain a specific grade.

A+ - The work contains evidence of exceptional thinking and/or research and/or presentation. The communication is excellent.

A – The work is comprehensive and includes all relevant points. These are communicated clearly. Presentation is excellent.

B – Most of the main points have been made and communicated clearly. Presentation is good.

C – Some of the main points have been included. There are some points missing or some confusion. Presentation is acceptable.

D – The work contains few relevant points. There are significant points missing. Presentation is poor.

E – The work contains little or no relevant material.

A '+' or '-' is attached if the work sits at the top or bottom of that grade.

An effort grade is also given.

- 1 – Excellent
- 2 – Good
- 3 – Satisfactory
- 4 – Poor
- 5 – Very Poor

You will also see there is a comment with your work. Please read this carefully as it will help your future learning.
